Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

"I am requesting a funding level of \$8,240,000 for the Sepulveda Basin Pedestrian Safety & Access Improvements Project as a community project funding request in fiscal year 2026. The intended recipient is the City of Los Angeles, located at 200 N Main Street Suite 1500, Los Angeles, CA 90012. The project would be a valuable use of taxpayer funds because the project will provide new and enhanced safe pedestrian pathways from underserved neighborhoods into Sepulveda Basin recreation area, providing car-free access to LA28 Games venues. Improvements include a new crosswalk at the east leg, curb ramps, lighting investments, bike racks, and benches. Additionally, the project will install High-intensity Activated Cross Walk beacons, including new crosswalks at east leg and curb ramps at Petit Ave and Gloria Ave.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 23 USC 133.
