Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

"I am requesting a funding level of \$3,000,000 for Grancell Village Affordable Senior Housing as a community project funding request in fiscal year 2026. The intended recipient is City of Los Angeles, located at 1500 City Hall East, Los Angeles, California, 90012. The project would be a valuable use of taxpayer funds because the funding would be used to provide low-income seniors living on fixed incomes with a safe and stable place to live. Funding this project would reduce homelessness – by providing a long-term solution rather than temporary shelter – and foster safer neighborhoods, as stable housing contributes to lower crime rates and more engaged residents.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(2).
