"I am requesting a funding level of \$2,500,000 for the Project imPACT, Community Reentry Program as a community project funding request in fiscal year 2025. The intended recipient is the City of Los Angeles, located at 200 N Main Street, Suite 1500, Los Angeles, CA 90012. The project would be a valuable use of taxpayer funds because the funding would be used for the Los Angeles Mayor's Office of Community Safety to continue to build out direct reentry service programming that enhances post-conviction poverty, and prevent recidivism, with a particular focus on support for housing.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes described in section 501 of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (34 U.S.C. § 10152).
