Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting a funding level of \$10,000,000 for Pacific Coast Highway (PCH) Wastewater Collection System – Fire Recovery Segment as a community project funding request in fiscal year 2027. The intended recipient is the City of Malibu, located at 23825 Stuart Ranch Road, Malibu, CA 90265. This project will allow for the design of a new wastewater collection system along 5.5 miles of PCH to replace damaged/aging onsite septic systems affected by the recent fires.

This project is a valuable use of taxpayer funds because it protects coastal waters, replacing aging and vulnerable septic systems with reliable infrastructure, reduces future maintenance costs, and improves the safety and resilience of a key coastal corridor.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Title VI of the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C. 1381 et seq.
