## A BILL

To codify the rule issued by the Federal Trade Commission relating to click-to-cancel, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Click to Cancel Act
- 5 of 2025".
- 6 SEC. 2. CODIFICATION OF CLICK-TO-CANCEL RULE.
- 7 (a) Codification.—The rule issued by the Federal
- 8 Trade Commission on November 15, 2024, relating to the

- 1 "Negative Option Rule" (89 Fed. Reg. 90476), shall have2 the force and effect of law.
- 3 (b) Enforcement.—
- (1) Unfair or deceptive acts or practices.—A violation of this section shall be treated as a violation of a regulation under section 18(a)(1)(B) of the Federal Trade Commission Act (15 U.S.C. 57a(a)(1)(B)) regarding unfair or deceptive acts or practices.
- 10 (2) Powers of Federal Trade Commis-11 SION.—The Federal Trade Commission shall enforce 12 this section in the same manner, by the same means, 13 and with the same jurisdiction, powers, and duties 14 as though all applicable terms and provisions of the 15 Federal Trade Commission Act (15 U.S.C. 41 et 16 seq.) were incorporated into and made a part of this 17 section, and any person who violates this section 18 shall be subject to the penalties and entitled to the 19 privileges and immunities provided in the Federal 20 Trade Commission Act.
